A special fan valve allows the adhesive to be applied across a wide surface area and offers the possibility to flexibly adjust the alignment by 360°. Adhesive Spray extra strong can be used for the bonding of felt, PVC foil, imitation leather, carpets, plastics, cardboard, foam and cellular rubber, insulating materials, soft foam, vinyl, leather, rubber, metal and wood. It is also suitable for bonding large surfaces.

Processing

1. Shake can before use. Surfaces must be dry, clean and free of grease. Spray on one surface at about 15 to 30 cm distance. With porous materials, Adhesive Spray should be applied on both surfaces. 2. Depending on surface characteristics and ambient temperature, let the spray dry (approx. 10 minutes) until the adhesive is no longer stringy. 3. Position the parts and join them with strong pressure.

Storage

Pressurized container. Protect from direct sunlight and temperatures above +50 °C.
